Go Boldly

Sow Broadly

Using digital, emerging and legacy media to share the gospel

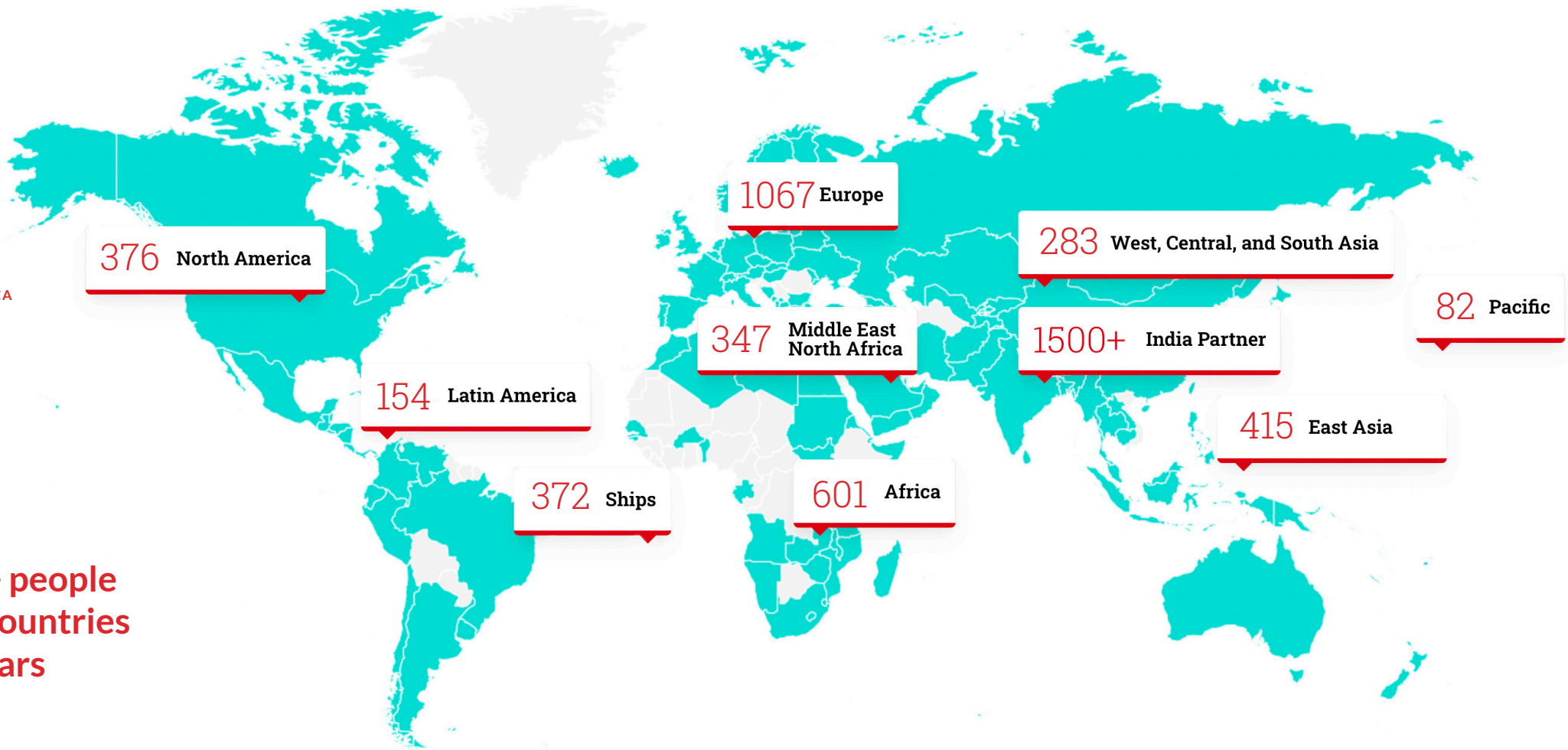
